

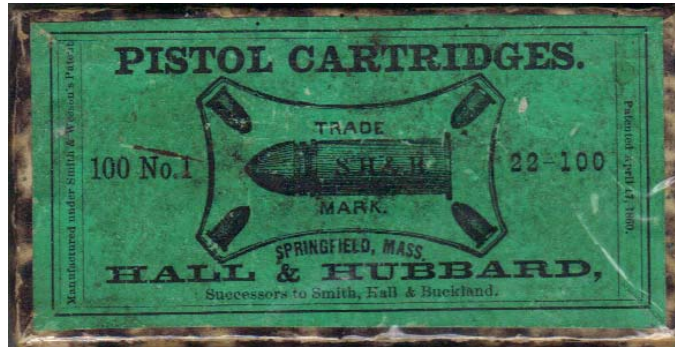

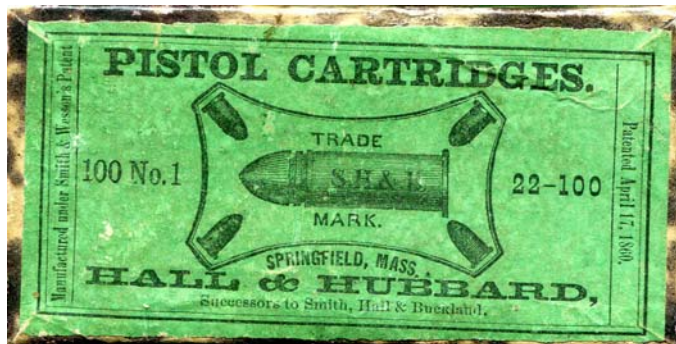

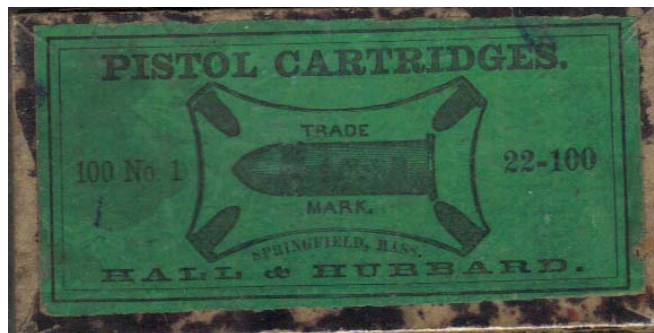

This manufacturer was a successors to SMITH, HALL & BUCKLAND. They produced cartridges from approx. 1869 till 1873.

S-1 .22 No. 1 PISTOL (BLANK). Orange label with black printing. Label only is known at this, so box type and contents are unknown.

S-2 .22 No.1 PISTOL. Green label with black printing. Black mottled, two-piece, half-split box. Green side sealing label with black printing. No h/s on a copper case. Lead bullet. Note: This box states HALL & HUBBARD are successors to SMITH, HALL & BUCKLAND) and also notes the SMITH & WESSON patents. This is a earlier box than S-3.

S-2.1 .22 No.1 PISTOL. Same as S-2 but vertical text is a different format.

S-3 .22 No. 1 PISTOL. Same as S-2 except the top label has no reference to SMITH, HALL & BUCKLAND or reference to the SMITH & WESSON patents. No h/s on a copper case. Lead bullet.
