During the early part of the 1860's, this manufacturer produced the revolver shown on the box top. It is assumed that this box was a private label for them, probably by C.D. LEET.

L-1 **.22 LONG.** "100 No.1 CARTRIDGES". Buff label with black printing. Two-piece, half-split box. No h/s on a copper case. Cast lead bullet.

+++**NOTE:** This box was listed in the original Dunn Catalog as a Short but it is now believed to be a Long.
